

The Day, the Day

In Luke's gospel, the women who came on Easter morning were intent on performing the rituals of grief but were thwarted by the emptiness of the tomb. Their first response was not joy but terror and confusion. Many of our modern mourning rituals were disrupted by the coronavirus pandemic, and the lack of closure may still cast a long shadow over the

grief people feel at the deaths of beloved family and friends. Lent is a time of facing up to the reality of death. The celebration of Easter breaks into the spiral of grief, but the stages of anger, denial, and bargaining continue to unfold. "Why do you look for the living among the dead?" the angel asks (Luke 24:5). Like the women at the tomb, many of us still find ourselves among the dead. Resurrection joy must find ways to continue to hold space for the rawness of death, especially when rituals of grief are disrupted. Come witness the resurrection and all that it means for your life of grace and forgiveness.
