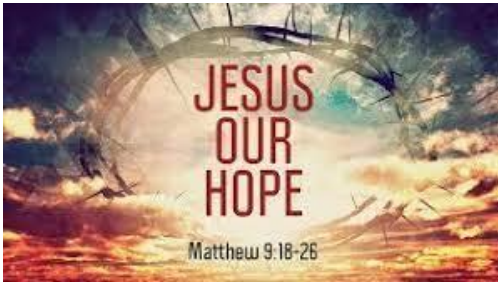

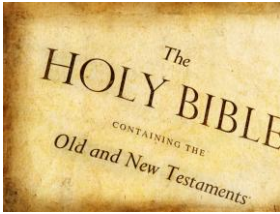

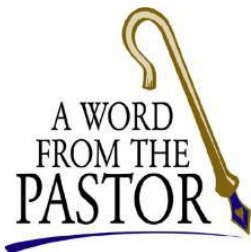


The Lessons for Sunday, June 7th – 2nd Sunday after Pentecost

Jesus- healer of the sick and sinful

Sunday's readings point to the mystery of holiness as a mystery of life-giving and love-sharing power. Such power begins and ends with life and love shared. This mystery is one the disciples of Christ are invited into, for he gives over his power to heal, to enlighten, and to love. That ideal of Christ's power, the power to care, to share, and to heal, has not
