

Praying for Us

This coming Sunday marks the end of the Easter season. In our gospel lesson Jesus does something special for his disciples then and now. Rather than giving them a lecture on what a disciple should and should not do, he prays for them and us. Not just any prayer but one that has been labeled as "The Highly Priestly Prayer." His prayer, I think would be

a prayer that a mother might pray for her family. Listen to these words and see if they don't reflect words that your mother or possibly your father might have prayed for you. They are also words that we should pray for our family.

Here is Jesus' first request: "Holy Father, keep them in thy name, which thou hast given me that they may be one, even as we are one."

Meaning- keep watch over, to guard, to preserve, to keep unharmed. Keep them close and one with God.

Next, Jesus prayed to the Father, "I have given them thy word." This encompasses God's Word and all that means.

Finally "That they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves."

Knowing that the family will face difficult circumstances, a parent prays that even in the worst of times we can have the best of joy in our hearts as we take to heart what Jesus has spoken to us.
